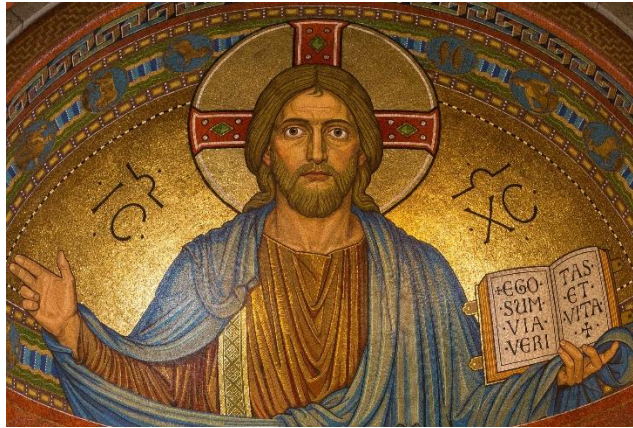


Course for Readers



“When the Sacred Scriptures are read in the Church, God himself speaks to his people” (GIRM, 29)

The purpose of this course is to train and form lay persons who wish to serve as Readers in their parishes. The course is designed both for beginners and for those who already have some experience in this service

The course will consider the liturgical, biblical, spiritual and technical aspects of the ministry of the Reader. Participants will have an opportunity to learn more about the importance of the liturgy in the Christian life and the place of Holy Scripture in liturgical celebrations. They will be introduced to some useful techniques of proclaiming the Word of God during the liturgy. They will also have the opportunity to learn more about the indispensable role that Sacred Scripture should play in the spiritual life of every Christian.
