Sacred Music – Parish Cantors and Musicians



"The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of inestimable value, greater even than that of any other art [because] it forms a necessary or integral part of the solemn liturgy." (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 112)

The purpose of this course is to train and form Parish Musicians to lead the sacred music in their parish setting. This one day workshop is designed to equip Parish Musicians (with confident vocal skills and good music literacy) to sing the texts of the liturgy and understand the various parts of the music of the Mass: Common, Ordinary, Proper, Hymns, Instrumental.

Participants in this course must have at least basic musical and vocal skills and a recommendation from their parish priest. For absolute beginners, the course 'Sacred Music – Congregants' is recommended as a good place to start their journey with sacred music.
